Treasurer Report

2020/2021 Season

- Opening balance \$657.09
- Collected \$3040.00 in team registrations
- Tour Championship was unable to occur due to COVID-19 restrictions, therefore all \$3040 was paid out to the top 10 men and top 10 women teams based on rankings at the end of the season. Breakdown can be requested.
- Expenses in the 2020/2021 season included:
 - \$41.44 for whiteboards for scorekeeping (COVID Protocol)
 - \$24.01 for envelope and stamps to mail team cheques.
- Closing balance was \$594.64

2021/2022 Season

- Opening balance was \$594.64
- Collected \$3200.00 in team registrations
- Charged \$85 per team for Tour Championship entry fee, equaling \$1360
- Tour Championship ice fees at the Heather were \$1350
- Paid out \$3220 for top 4 team at the Tour Championship
- Connor Njegovan donated \$250 for advertising his Real-estate business on MJCT Website
- No expenses this season
- Closing balance of \$834.64

Discussion occurred regarding allowing e-transfers for team entries, registrations, etc. Karen Letham will look at options with financial institution.

Website Update

- Discussed the inclusion of team pages including sponsors and logo on the website
- Discussed the creation of a repository for players that are wanting to compete but are not on a team. This could include a player profile.

Bonspiel Coordinator Update

- Registrations this season included 13 women teams and 11 men teams
- There were nine MJCT Events totaling 73 entries for men, and 64 entries for women
- Altona will be hosting a MJCT event March 11-13, 2022
- Morris will be hosting a MJCT event at the end of March
- The Elmwood MJCT event will be in the spring
- Cost for ice rental is increasing so may have to look at increasing our registration costs to \$250 to help offset

New Business

- Darryl Friesen provided alcoates to the committee for volunteering their own time to create and run events for the junior teams to compete. Has seen great evolution in the MJCT and the addition of an Altona event is great. Darryl commented that many of the committee members are involved because they have kids that compete, but Albert selflessly gives up his own time so the kids can play.
- MJCT Committee will contact clubs to ensure their junior programs are aware of the MJCT and provide them with contact information to reach out with any questions.
