

## **Larry Jones Junior Classic Protocols and Procedures**

Doors will open 20 minutes before each draw

**Masks to be worn in the club areas at all times. Masks are optional on ice**

Use the main entrance on Regal Avenue only

**Coaches to wear masks at all times**

Sanitize hands upon entry

**Coaches to submit all COVID forms for their team prior to the first game**

Teams will come dressed to curl. No changing at the club

**Teams playing on sheets 1, 2 & 3 will enter the club, sanitize and proceed directly upstairs**

**Teams playing on sheets 4, 5 & 6 will enter the club, sanitize and proceed to the locker room**

Teams playing on sheets 1, 2 & 3 will have tables upstairs; they will change their shoes there

Teams playing on sheets 4, 5 & 6 will change their shoes in the cloakroom room, return to the main floor via the main stairs & proceed to their tables

**Teams playing on sheet 1, 2 & 3 will proceed via the back staircase to the east ice entrance (sheet #1)**

**Teams playing on sheets 4, 5 & 6 will proceed to the ice via the west ice entrance (sheet #6)**

Teams will enter in this order: Sheets 1 & 6, sheets 3 & 4, and sheets 2 & 5

**Teams will sanitize their hands before entering the ice**

Teams will follow Curling Canada protocols for on-ice positioning

**One sweeper rule in effect.**

Coaches on sheets 2 & 5 will have their coaching table upstairs: sheets 1, 3, 4, & 6 will coach from the main floor

**Teams shooting yellow will take their 3-minute break inside on the main floor, teams shooting blue will take theirs at the home end.**

Doors to the club will be locked after the games commence

**Teams will proceed directly to their change area after the game, change, and leave via the main entrance.**

Only those ordering food will be allowed to stay until their order is ready

**No spectators allowed. Select games will be available via live stream**

Coaches will be responsible for ensuring all items are removed from the team table after each game.

**Please remember to maintain social distancing as much as possible**
